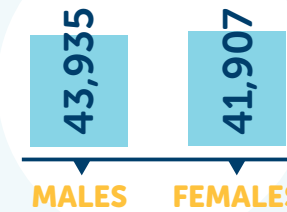

The Eyre, Flinders & Far North region is:



Above the state average rate for:

- Self reported high psychological distress (SAMSS)
- Anti-depressant and antipsychotic prescriptions (people aged 18-64)
- ADHD related prescriptions



Below the state average rate for:

- Self reported current mental health condition (SAMSS)
- PTS referrals
- GP Mental Health Plans prepared
- Anxiolytic prescriptions (people aged 18-64)

Establishment of a 'no wrong door' approach.



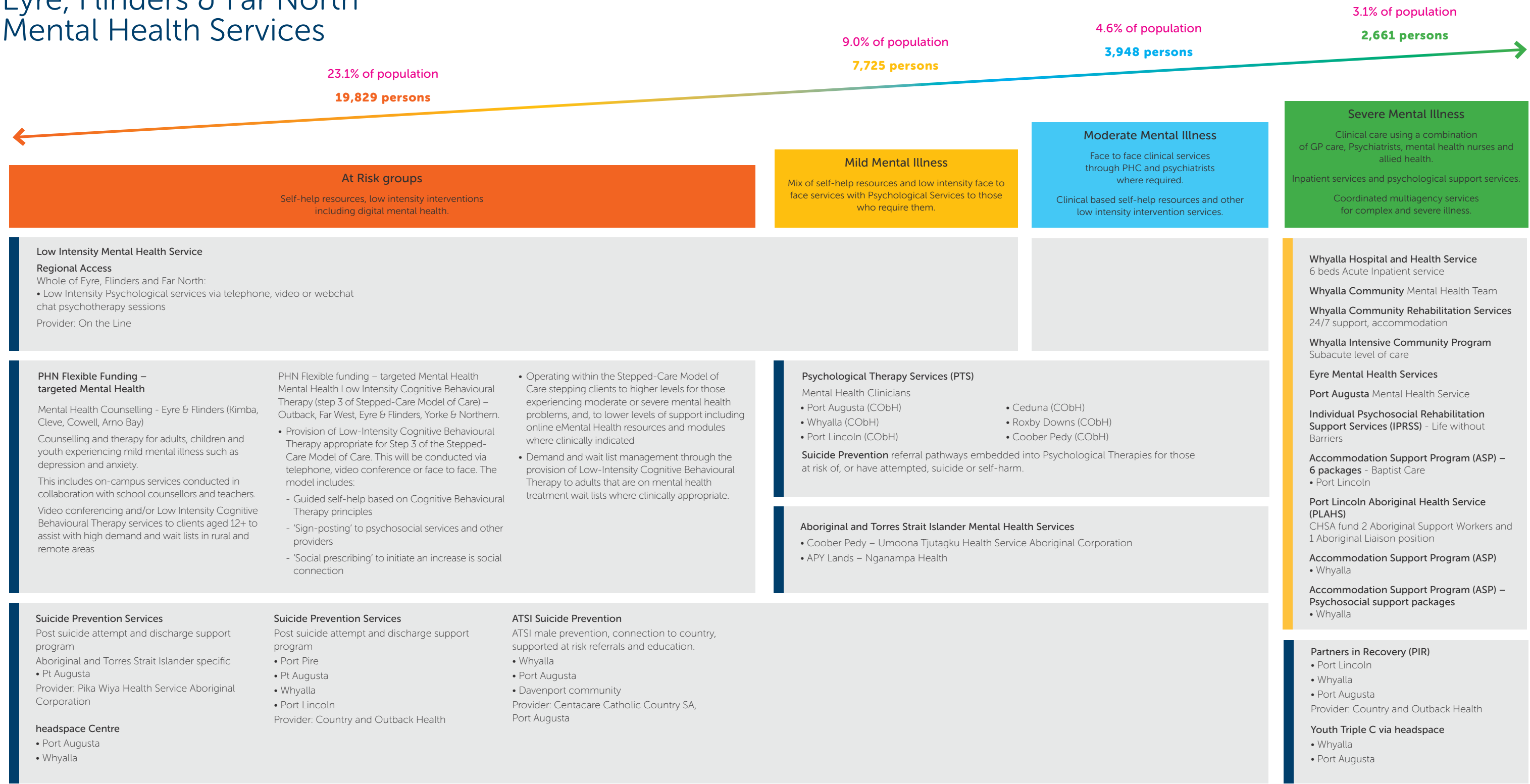
The provision of after-hours services (after 5pm weekdays and on weekends)
