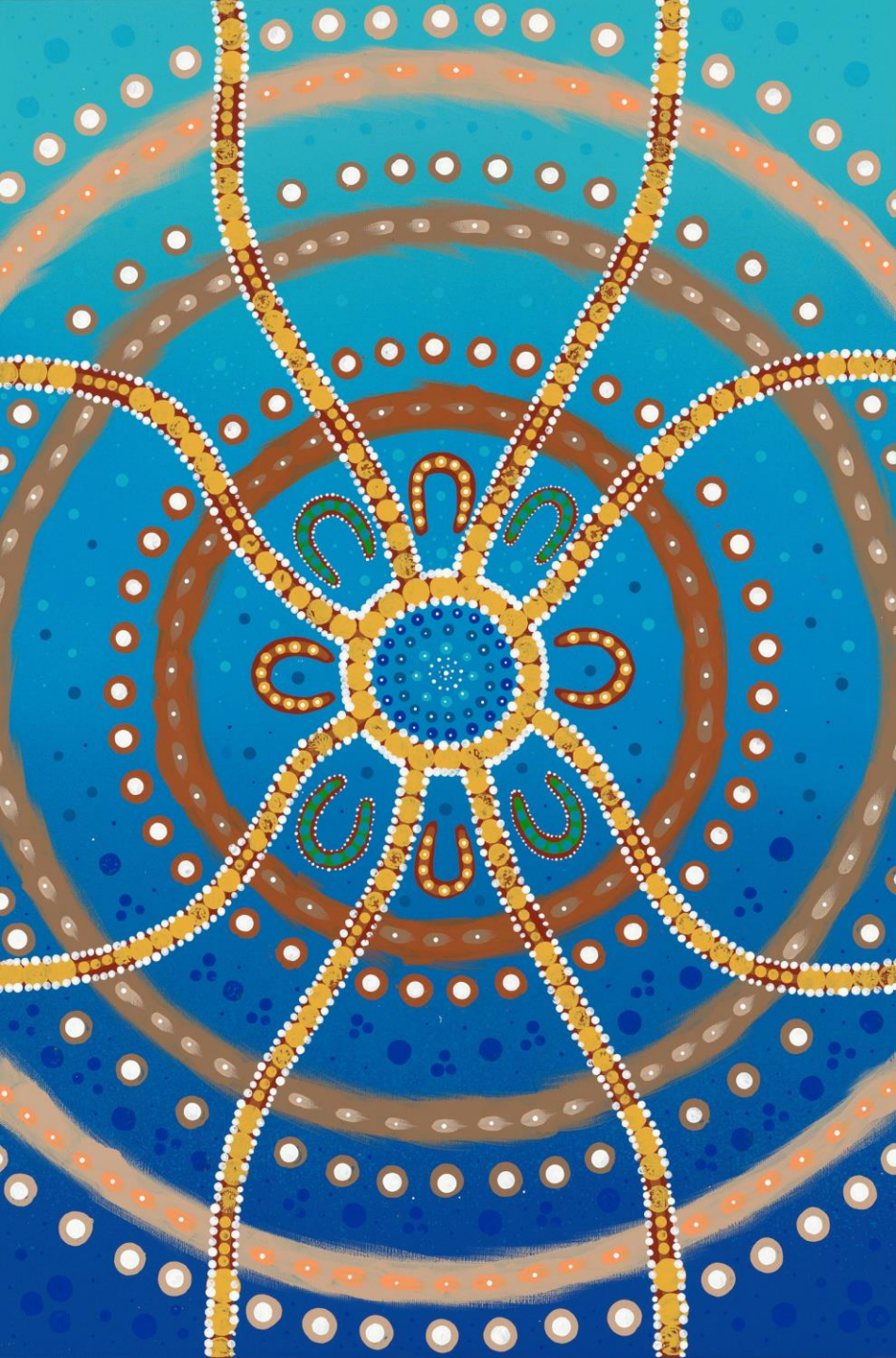

For those RACFs that wish to participate

- Digital enablement grants to support with establishing suitable virtual health consultation, including required IT hardware, software and training.

Priority	Timeline
Establishment of telehealth grants	From July 2022
Training & education for use of digital solutions in RACF workflows	From October 2022

After Hours support

For those RACFs that wish to participate

- Provide guidance to assist that appropriate after-hours plans in place
- Engagement between RACFs and their residents GPs

Priority	Timeline
Consultations with participating RACF's to understand the after-hours plans that they have in place	From July 2022
Integrating RACF's to have after hours action plans in place	August 2022 – June 2024

Care Finder

Establish and maintain a network of care finders

Priority	Timeline
Undertake supplementary needs assessment	July – August 2022
Confirm ACH providers to transition to care finder program	August 2022
Approach to market	August- September 2022
care finder contracts issued	November 2022
Communities of Practice established	From November 2022
care finder commissioned services to commence	1 Jan 2023 – 30th June 2025

Early intervention initiatives to support healthy ageing and ongoing management of chronic conditions

Commissioned activity based on PHNs needs assessment




- Support senior Australians to live in the community for longer (including those not currently receiving aged care services) - promote healthy ageing, slow decline and support the ongoing management of chronic conditions.
- Support collaborative approaches between multidisciplinary teams and primary care providers.
